Lead Junior Coach

OVERALL PURPOSE OF THE POSITION

Responsible for planning and coaching a variety of squad programs including the following core functions:

- Coaching squads, including attendance at club nights and swim meets
- Attend and assist with school related swim meets, championships and training sessions as instructed
- Undertake lifeguard and pool attendant duties when required

PRIMARY DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES

Coaching – The primary purpose of this role is Lead Junior Coach (primary responsibility to the Barker Junior School). However, they will also at times be required to coach or assist with school groups, senior school squads and intensive programs. This requires well-developed communication and organisational skills, and the ability to teach swimming principles to a variety of skill levels. Components of this function include:

- Conduct all squads in an enthusiastic and professional manner
- Maintain discipline amongst squad members
- Develop and implement annual training plans for assigned squads
- Plan and deliver day-to-day training sessions within a seasonal framework
- Assist swimmers to develop skills and technique, and continually provide feedback throughout training sessions
- Liaise with parents / guardians regarding their children's development and upcoming events
- Attend regular meetings with other coaching staff to discuss swimmers, future plans for the squads, and other issues that may affect the overall performance of the squads
- Attend carnivals as directed, providing swimmers with performance feedback before and after each event
- Provide assistance and guidance to junior coaches

School Swimming – Assist with school programs and meets including:

- Junior School and Secondary School swim meets and Championships
- New student orientation
- Time trials
- Coaching and teaching of school programs
- · Administration and coaching support

Barker Aquatic Swim Club

- Participate and assist in Barker Aquatic Club activities
- Encourage membership in Barker Aquatic Club events
- Encourage participation in Barker Aquatic Club events
